How do we Church?

The Church Model

Our Church is led by a TEAM of Elders who oversee the different ministries in the life of the church. We believe that there is an opportunity for everyone to be involved in what God has called us to do We believe that the local church should be :

1. Autonomus and Self Governed yet accountable to an outside team , in our case it's NCMI.

 Self Financing - Financed by tithes and offerings of the local believers
 Eldership Governed - not authoritarian , but led bat a Team of ELders who, together with the lead elder, help set the Vision, Direction and Doctrine of the church

4. A dynamic model which allows for feedback and participation of everyone in the chuech with Jesus Christ as the Vision

The Church Governance

As stated we believe that Jesus Christ is the Head of the Church .We believe in the New Testament model of church Government where we see Apostles planting, establishing and working into Local Churches, raising up an Eldership Team who would then lead and govern the local church working together with a team of Deacons. (Titus 1 v 5. Acts 14 v 21-28.) 1 Tim 5 v 17 The elders who direct the affairs of the church well are worthy of double honour, especially those whose work is preaching and teaching. Note ~ It is the elders (plural) and not boards or deacons who are to "direct the affairs of the church". Leadership at all levels is always in plurality ~ Church Acts 15 v 22. Elders Acts 20 v 17-31. 1 Pet 5 v 1. Deacons Acts 6 v 1-7. Translocal Eph 4 v 11-16.

Biblical Leadership

Biblical Leadership is one of shepherding, going ahead of the sheep, leading them to green pastures and still waters Ps 23 and protecting the sheep against savage wolves, Acts 20v29. Leadership starts at Home 1 Tim 3v5, "If anyone does not know how to manage his own family, how can he take care of God's church ?" The Greek word here is -proistemi- which means to stand before. Our leadership style should therefore not simply be one of management or rulership but one of standing in front – of a shepherd – leading by example – inspiring – protecting – caring.

Leaders should always have the heart of a father ~ wanting their children to go further. By: 1. ~ Building away from themselves and not towards themselves (1 Cor 4 v 17. Acts 8 v 4–17.). 2 ~ Being prepared to pass on the Baton (Deut 34 v 4–9. John 20 v 21,22.). 3 ~ Going beyond the 3rd Generation (2 Tim 2 v 1–2. Ps 103 v 17).

Our Statement of Faith

WE BELIEVE:

1. In the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments in their original writing as fully inspired by God, and accept them as the full and final authority for faith and life.

2. In one God eternally existing in three persons – Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

3. That the Lord Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, and is true God and true Man.

4. That God created man in His image; that man sinned and thereby incurred the penalty of death, physical and spiritual, and that all human beings inherit a sinful nature which issues in actual transgression involving personal guilt.

5. That the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins, a substitutionary sacrifice, according to the Scriptures, and that all who believe and trust in Him are justified on the grounds of His shed blood.

6. In the bodily resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, His ascension into heaven, and His present life as our High Priest and Advocate.

7. In the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ.
8. In the personality of the Holy Spirit, His regenerating work, and abiding presence in the true believer. That the Holy Spirit indwells all true believers and that He has been sent to be the Comforter and Empowerer of the Christian Church, to produce the fruit of the Holy Spirit and the gifts of the Holy Spirit according to the Scriptures.

9. That all who repent of their sin and receive the Lord Jesus Christ by faith are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God.

10. That all Christians are called to a life of holiness, devotion to the Lord Jesus Christ and service to Him.



Our Statement of Faith

11. In the resurrection both of the just and the unjust, the eternal blessedness of the redeemed, and the eternal banishment from God of those who have rejected the offer of salvation.

12. That the whole company of those who have accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as their Saviour have been redeemed by Him and regenerated by the Holy Spirit and form the one true Church, and that each local church on earth should take its character from this concept. Therefore, the new birth and personal confession of faith in Christ are essentials of Church membership.

13. In the priesthood of all believers in Jesus Christ.
14. That the ascended Christ has given various ministries or ministers to the Church in order to bring all believers to the place of Christian maturity in the understanding of truth, and the performance and function of the ministry (Ephesians 4:11; Romans 12:4- 8 and 1 Corinthians 12:10).

15. That the healing of the sick in the name of Jesus Christ is still active in the Church (Mark 16:16-18; Matthew 8:16-17; 1 Corinthians 12:9; James 5:14-15).
16. That God never removed the gifts of the Holy Spirit from the Church, and that the Scriptural commands to "seek earnestly the best gifts", and to "forbid not to speak in tongues", are still applicable today (1 Corinthians 12,13 & 14:1-39).

17. That the miracles as recorded in the Bible were real miracles, and are possible in the present day (John 14:12 and 1 Corinthians 12:10).

18. That all believers are called to fulfill the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20).That Christ is the Head of His body, the Church, and that in all things He has pre-eminence



Our Phílosophy





We believe that our mission and vision must flow through a structure (wineskin). Further we see vision not only as what we ourselves are doing and becoming but also what role God has called us to play in working with the rest of His church in fulfilling His purposes in the earth.

David served the purposes of God in His generation (Acts10v36). Our passion is to do the same. The structure that we see in the new testament could be called an Apostolic & Prophetic Wineskin. A wine skin has a purpose, function and certain shape and must be flexible. The purpose of the wineskin is simply to receive, contain and distribute the Wine. We need a New Wineskin to administer the New Wine ~ The Holy Spirit.

In Luke 5 v 37 Jesus said, "And no one pours new wine into old wineskins. If he does, the new wine will burst the skins, the wine will run out and the wineskins will be ruined. 38 No, new wine must be poured into new wineskins."

In order to accomplish all God has for us as a local church we are totally convinced that we must be governed by the authority of God's Word. Led by a Team of Elders who are in relationship and submission to an Apostolic Team, this we believe is the Biblical Pattern/Structure/Wineskin as laid out in the New Testament. Every local church, while retainina its autonomy should relate to an Apostolic/Prophetic Team. While the Elders are the highest form of government in the local church, the church must still relate and be accountable to an Apostolic/Prophetic Team through it's Elders (Acts 8v 4-14, 11 v 22-24).

We also believe that every member is a part of the Team and as such has a part to play. ~ Together Everyone Achieves More ~ The Dynamic of TEAM is one of equal importance but different function.

We cannot win unless the whole Team plays together ~ it is not important who scores the goal but that the Team wins. God's Team ~ Gen 1 v 26-28. Moses' Team ~ Num 11 v 6. David's Team ~ 2 Sam 23 v 8-39. Jesus' Team ~ Mk 3 v 13-19. Peter's Team Acts 2 v 14. Paul's Team ~ Acts 14 v 21-28. Marriage Team ~ Gen 1 v 26-28. 1 Cor 9 v 5

WE as JMR Church relate to NCMI

NCMI is not a grouping of churches, a denomination, a movement or an organization. It is simply a name given to a team with recognized Ephesians 4:11 gifts (apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers) who partner in their commitment to the same vision of working, on a grass-roots level, with local churches to accomplish God's mandate of making disciples of all nations.

NCMI History

NCMI had its beginnings in South Africa during the early 1980's. Dudley Daniel, who was leading a church in Johannesburg, South Africa, began to meet regularly with other pastors and leaders in the city for relaxed discussion around God's Word. As 'iron sharpened iron' and friendships grew, so did a common concern for the church in the nation. Along with a growing common vision came recognition and respect for the reality of each other's gifting in God. Labels or titles were never claimed or used (as it is to this day) but during that time an authentic acceptance of each person's gifting in God was formed.

As the work grew, God began to birth an even greater passion for the nations in the hearts of the growing NCMI team. One result of this conviction was that in January 1990, Dudley and his wife Ann responded to God's call to relocate to Adelaide, South Australia. In Australia, a church base from which to further resource church planting into Australasia was established.

Not long after Dudley and Ann relocated, a wave of church planting was released, initially from South Africa, and then later from Australia and other countries. This momentum continues up to the present time and has resulted in many churches being planted around the world. The number of existing churches that chose to partner with NCMI in the work grew rapidly. By 2012, pastors, churches, and individuals from more than 100 countries around the world were partnering with NCMI in embracing an apostolicprophetic model to participate in the various opportunities for envisioning, encouragement, training and church planting.
